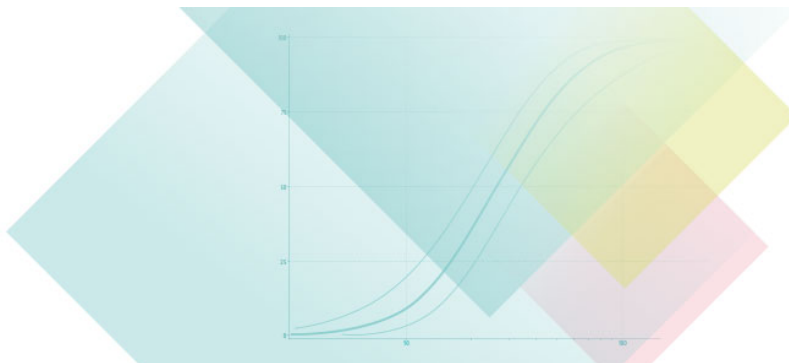


Codex Alimentarius Maximum Residue Level (Codex MRL)



For registrations of plant protection products, many countries worldwide are using the **Codex Alimentarius MRLs** for a wide variety of pesticides. The **Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC)** is an intergovernmental body to implement the Joint **FAO/WHO** Food Standards Programme and is responsible for setting up **Codex MRLs**. Its principle objective is to protect the health of consumers and to facilitate the worldwide trade of food. SCC can help you with the setting of the **Codex MRLs**.

It is important to note, that when the plant protection product is marketed within the EU, the maximum residue levels are not allowed to exceed the **EU-MRL**, even if the **Codex MRL** is higher.
